Group transfer from Rome airport to Spoleto.

Visit of Spoleto and lunch in the historic center.

Guided visit of the historical center of Florence.

Guided visit of the Duomo with Dome and Bell Tower.

Free time in Florence.

Guided visit of Uffizi Gallery.

Transfer to Pienza

Walk in Pienza and tour of the town.

Visit to a farm with cheese production.

Lunch and cheese tasting at the farm.

Transfer to Bagno Vignoni.

Walk in Bagno Vignoni and dinner.

Overnight at Agriturismo Fattoria del Colle - Castiglione d'Orcia

• **DAY 8 - 28/10 Wednesday - Siena.**

Transfer to Siena.  
Guided visit of Siena.  
Free lunch in the historic center of Siena.  
Free time in Siena.  
Transfer to Val d'Orcia.  
Cooking class of typical Sienese dishes and dinner in Agriturismo.  
Overnight at Agriturismo Fattoria del Colle - Castiglione d'Orcia

• **DAY 9 - 29/10 Thursday - Orvieto.**

Transfer to Orvieto.  
Walk in Orvieto e and visit of St. Patrick's Well  
Lunch in a restaurant in Orvieto.  
Transfer to Rome.  
Hotel's check-in and dinner in a restaurant at Trastevere  
Overnight at Hotel dei Mellini - Rome

• **DAY 10 - 30/10 Friday - Rome and the Pantheon.**

Walk to Rome's city center with a guide.  
Visit to Campo dei Fiori, Piazza Navona, and entrance to the Pantheon.  
Lunch in Rome's city center.  
Free afternoon.  
Dinner at a restaurant near the hotel.  
Overnight at Hotel dei Mellini - Rome

• **DAY 11 - 31/10 Saturday - Vatican Museums**

Transfer by minivan to Città del Vaticano.  
Visit of Basilica di San Pietro.  
Lunch in a restaurant.  
Visit of Vatican Museums.  
Farewell dinner.  
Overnight at Hotel dei Mellini - Rome

• **DAY 12 - 1/11 Sunday - Free day in Rome and Departure from Rome Airport.**

After breakfast, goodbyes to the tour guides and free day in Rome.  
Free lunch and dinner.  
In the evening transfer to Rome airport and end of services.

## GENERAL INFORMATIONS

### FAIRS AND CONDITIONS

#### NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS, LANGUAGE SPOKEN

The minimum group size is 14 participants, the maximum is 20. With fewer participants, the fee must be recalculated. The common language spoken by the guide, Dr. Fu-Ju Yang, will be Chinese, while the Italian agency representative will speak Italian and English.

**Eur 1.500,00 deposit** to be paid upon booking, by **January 31st, 2026**. The **balance** must be paid by **September 10th, 2026**, and in any case, within one month of departure.

The deposit receipt will be sent online via email. After payment of the balance, the invoice for the full amount of the trip will be sent in the same manner.

\* The names of the hotels are indicated in the program for each day; however, for reasons beyond the control of the Organizer, some hotels may be replaced with hotels of the same or higher category. Please note that rooms of the same type in different hotels may be of different categories. These are often old buildings that were not originally designed for accommodation, with rooms that differ from one another; some are small establishments with only a few rooms. We will endeavor to distribute the higher category rooms evenly on a case-by-case basis.

## **FEE DOESN'T INCLUDE**

- Medical insurance, baggage insurance, and trip cancellation insurance.
- Transportation from your place of residence to Rome
- Extra services, meals and tips not included, and anything not expressly mentioned in the program and under FEE INCLUDES.

\* Given the importance of the tourist package, we strongly recommend taking out medical and travel cancellation insurance (which also includes flights). It is advisable to take out this insurance in your own country for ease of management in the event of a claim.

## **CONFIRMATION OF THE TRIP**

The trip will be confirmed when the **minimum number of 14** registrations is reached. **The final confirmation date for the trip is January 31st, 2026.**

Once the trip has been confirmed, additional registrations will be accepted, up to a maximum of 20 participants, by February 15, 2026.

## **WITHDRAWAL AND PENALTIES**

The traveler may withdraw from the contract at any time. In the event of cancellation by the traveler, the following penalties apply:

- from the date of booking until April 30, 2026, a penalty equal to half of the deposit paid;
- from May 1 to September 9, 2026, a penalty equal to the entire deposit paid.
- from September 10, the deadline for payment of the balance, to October 21, a penalty of 100%.

Travelers who find themselves in a situation where they have to cancel their trip may need to file a claim with their insurance company, as cancellation insurance is not included in this travel package.

If, after booking, the traveler is unable to participate, they may transfer the Contract to a person who meets all the conditions for using the service (e.g., the same type of room) by giving the Organizer advance notice by email no later than seven days before the start of the trip.

In any case, the Organizer will retain 4% of the amount paid as reimbursement for administrative expenses and recovery of costs related to money transactions relating to the payment of the deposit or balance.

As this is a tailor-made trip organized on specific request, in the event of cancellation by a participant, which would reduce the number of participants below the minimum requirement of fourteen travelers, the cost of the trip will have to be recalculated and the registered travelers will have to pay the additional amount necessary to ensure the sustainability of the trip. If the new price is not accepted, the trip will have to be canceled, but all expenses already incurred by the Organizer will be retained.

This condition applies to the phase of the trip already confirmed with payment of the deposit only. After payment of the balance, no additional payment will be required as it will be considered a penalty for withdrawal.

## **INFOS AND CHANGES TO THE PROGRAM**

Before departure, useful information about the trip will be sent by email, in particular the names and contact details of the tour leaders and any other additional information.

The above program may be subject to change before or during the tour due to technical or organizational reasons or weather conditions that prevent certain outdoor activities from taking place. Consequently, some services such as hotels, excursions, visits, tastings, or others may be replaced with other services of the same type, quality, or value, at the sole discretion of the Organizer or tour guides.

The program may also be subject to changes or restrictions in the event of emergency government regulations regarding public health. The causes cannot be predicted and are beyond the control of the Organizer.
